Event: Welcome Party – Cocktail Hour

Address: High Tide – 1 Water Street, Brooklyn NY

Time: 6 – 8 pm

Located on Pier 1 by the Brooklyn Bridge, High Tide is an outdoor cocktail bar & seafood restaurant. From the Brooklyn Bridge Marriott or Aloft Downtown Brooklyn, it is a 15min walk to the venue. See the map below. Alternatively, it is a 5min ride in an Uber or taxi. If you are coming from elsewhere in the city, the closest subway stations are the York Street F Train, and the High Street A/C station. Additionally, the Water Taxi docks just steps away from the bar.

There will be drinks, appetizers, oysters, and fun! This is cocktail hour so there will be light bites and oysters, but this is not intended to be a full dinner. If you are looking for somewhere to eat, either before or afterwards, we invite you to try one of the many amazing restaurants in the Downtown Brooklyn neighborhood.

Saturday

Event: Wedding Ceremony / Reception

Address: Brooklyn Grange, Sunset Park – 850 3rd Ave (Rooftop), Brooklyn, NY

Time: 5 – 10pm

The entrance to the venue is located via an elevator at the far end of the building where an elevator will take you up to the roof. There will be staff members and signs pointing in the right direction, but if all else fails, just type "Captain America Statue" into the search bar of your map. (Yes there is an actual Captain America Statue at the entrance. Jim likes comic books. This can't be that surprising.) For those driving, there is plenty of parking.

For those traveling from the downtown Brooklyn hotels, there will be a shuttle that will take you to the ceremony from the Hotel. **The shuttle will be set to depart from the Marriott Brooklyn Bridge at 4pm to allow for any potential traffic,** so please be on time and ready to go. (Otherwise, a ride-share like Uber or Lyft is your best option.)

The Ceremony will begin promptly at 5pm, followed by the Reception and Dinner after.

(The reception and dinner are an open bar, but please remember to bring cash if you wish to tip the staff.)

Following the reception there will be a shuttle bus that will pick up anybody wishing to head back to the hotels.

For those wishing to keep the festivities going, there will also be a 56 passenger bus to carry us to the afterparty at a bar in our neighborhood in East Williamsburg. Common Mollies is one of our favorite local bars. There will be music and drinks until late, but the bus is one-way, so please be prepared to take an Uber or Lyft back if you are staying in one of the hotels.

Sunday

Event: Farewell Brunch in Bushwick

Address: (Our Apartment!) The Denizen – 123 Melrose Street, Brooklyn NY

Time: 11am – 2pm

For those who could use a little recovery, come on over to our home for a traditional Brooklyn style brunch—meaning bagels, breakfast sandwiches, and cocktails. When you arrive at the building entrance, check in with the front desk staff. They will point you in the direction of the elevator which will take you up to the 8th Floor lounge where we will have a spread of our favorite neighborhood bagels, lox, and cream cheeses, as well as some delicious cocktails to help out anybody who might have partied a little too hard the night before. If you are flying out there is plenty of room to park your bags, so you don't have to go straight to the airport after checking out of the hotel.

Rides to JFK from our apartment are typically around \$50-60 and take about 30 – 45mins

Rides to LGA are usually between \$40-50 and take about 20 – 30mins

Rides to EWR are typically around \$90-110 and can take between 55mins – 1.5hr depending on traffic
